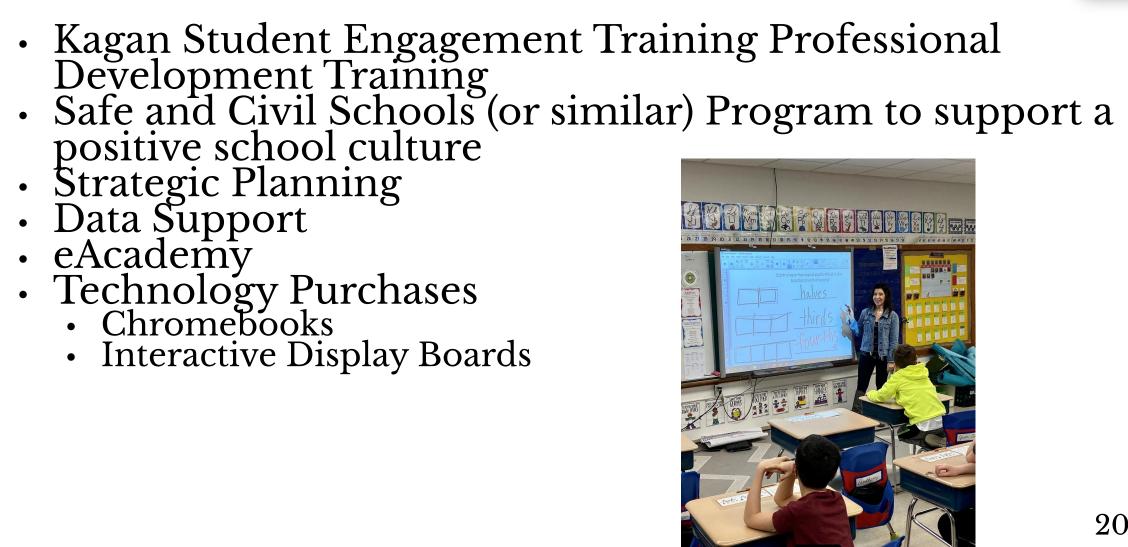

American Rescue Plan (ARPA) – Initial Guidance

- Districts are required to post ARP Funding Plans on their websites
- Use of ARPA funds must describe how the district will;
 - "address the academic impact of **lost instructional time** through the implementation of **evidence-based interventions**"
 - "respond to the academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs of all students, and particularly those students disproportionately impacted by the pandemic"
 - "plan for the safe return to in-person instruction and continuity of services for all schools, including those that have already returned to in-person instruction."
