FIVE WINTER SPORTS TEAMS NAMED NYSPHSAA SCHOLAR ATHLETE TEAMS

AKRON, NEW YORK (March 27, 2025) – Akron Central Schools is pleased to announce that five out of six Winter 2024-25 varsity sports teams are New York State Public High School Athletic Association (NYSPHSAA) Scholar-Athlete Teams. NYSPHSAA honors teams at the end of each sports season with certificates and pins.

The Akron High School varsity teams designated Scholar-Athlete Teams and their team averages are Boys Basketball, 90.04; Girls Basketball, 96.53; Boys Swimming, 94.08; Girls Swimming, 95.80; and Winter Competitive Cheer, 94.54.

The overall average of the five Akron High School award-winning teams is 94.20.

To receive Scholar-Athlete team recognition, the team's average GPA for 75% of the roster must be greater than or equal to 90.00.
