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Executive Summary







Akron CSD 2023 Capital Improvement Project *Executive Summary*April 2025

Overview

Campus Construction Management Group (CCMG) is pleased to report on the progress taken part within the 2023 Capital Improvement Project.

Phase I:

Transportation Facility

In the month of April, TCS finished setting new structural steel, bar joists, metal deck, stair stringers, and stair pans throughout the Transportation Facility Addition. TCS also started cold-formed metal framing and sheathing for exterior walls, and completed roofing substrate board and vapor barrier. Numarco installed new roof drains, and Goodwin roughed-in newly framed exterior walls and soffits for new electrical devices and fixtures.

In the Addition Bus Wash Bay, Numarco finished underslab sanitary work and set new trench drains. Mollenberg-Betz installed gridded insulation, radiant tubing, and roughed in sensors for the in-slab radiant heating system. TCS completed subbase prep, installed rebar, and poured the new concrete slab in the Bus Wash Bay.

Exterior cold-formed metal framing and remaining interior concrete slabs for the Addition will be complete by mid-May. Interior stud walls and MEP roughs will follow the completion of the floor slabs.

K-12 Educational Building

Over April Break, TCS abated VCT flooring and mastic down to concrete substrate in the Elementary School Bathrooms. TCS completed wall tile and expansion joints work in the Pool, and also installed the new ADA lift. Mollenberg-Betz performed pre-construction testing, adjusting, and balancing throughout for upcoming work areas.

Phase II:

The bid period concluded in early April for the traditionally bid prime contracts for Site Work, General Trades, Mechanical, and Electrical work. All bid packages were highly competitive and came in well under budget, inclusive of awarding all alternates. Contracts were successfully awarded to Northeast Diversification, NCI Construction, John W. Danforth, and CIR Electrical. Each Contractor has begun their start-up paperwork and submittal process.

Work for the new Athletic Complex will commence after the spring sports season.

Construction Project Schedules

In Section 3 of this report, please find the current Phase I Construction Schedule and Phase II Bid Schedule. The project schedules provide a description of overall activities and their associated durations for construction.

With most contracts now awarded to Prime Contractors for Phase II, Contractor feedback regarding the sequence and duration of construction activities has been collected and is being integrated into a detailed construction schedule. Once the detailed construction schedule is refined, it will be distributed to all Contractors for feedback and buy-in.

The project schedules for the 2023 Capital Improvement Project were developed with the OACM Team, based on District priorities and program needs. CCMG will continue to work with the District Administration to understand evolving department needs, manage the overall schedule, and report on current construction progress.

Budget Summary

In Section 4 of this report, please find the current Project Budget Summary. The overall project budget summary reports that the project is on budget. Highlights to this include:

- 1. Incidental Budget is \$4,596,606.
- 2. Total Construction Contingency Budget is \$1,626,226.
- 3. Total Phase I Change Orders Executed is \$2,026.
- 4. Total Phase I Change Orders Pending is (\$66,114).
- 5. Total Phase I Allowances Used is \$15,000.
- 6. Total Phase I Allowances Available is \$0.
- 7. Total Phase II Change Orders Executed is \$0.
- 8. Total Phase II Change Orders Pending is \$0.
- 9. Total Phase II Allowances Used is \$0.
- 10. Total Phase II Allowances Available is \$45,500.
- 11. Total Construction Contingency Remaining is \$1,690,314.

Of the \$1,626,226 budgeted for the Construction Contingency, sixteen (16) Field Orders have been generated which have turned into one (1) Change Order to date.

In the Field Order log, the project team is tracking current issues and allocated estimate dollar values for potentially added construction work, as captured under Change Orders Pending. Once a change order is processed for signing, the final cost associated with it will total under Change Orders Executed. Please reference the Field Order log for more information on current issues.

Note, the Total Phase I Change Orders Pending value is currently a credit that is being carried back into the Construction Contingency Remaining value.

Should there ever be additional information you would like as part of the monthly reports, please advise and our team will make the adjustment. 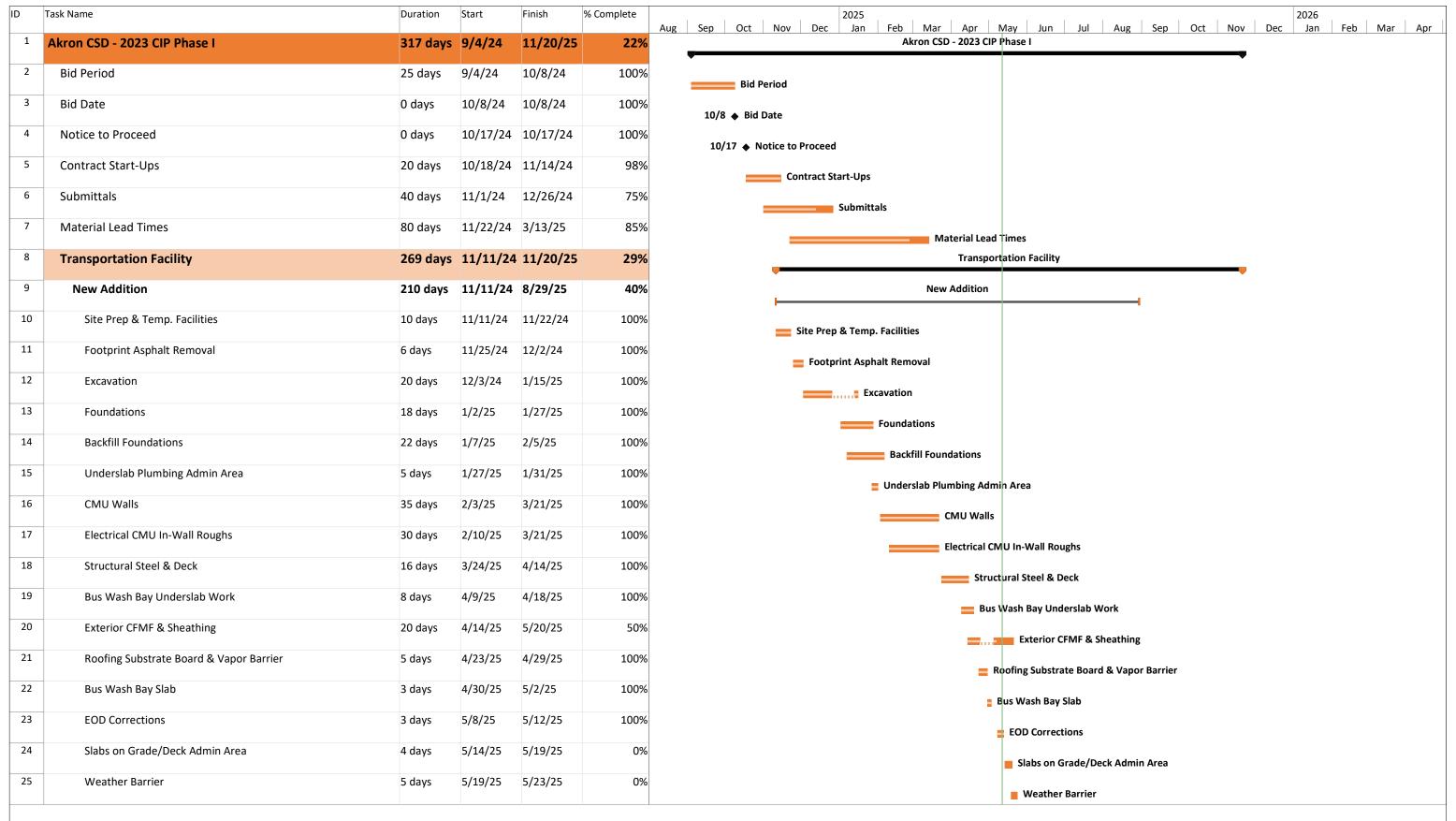

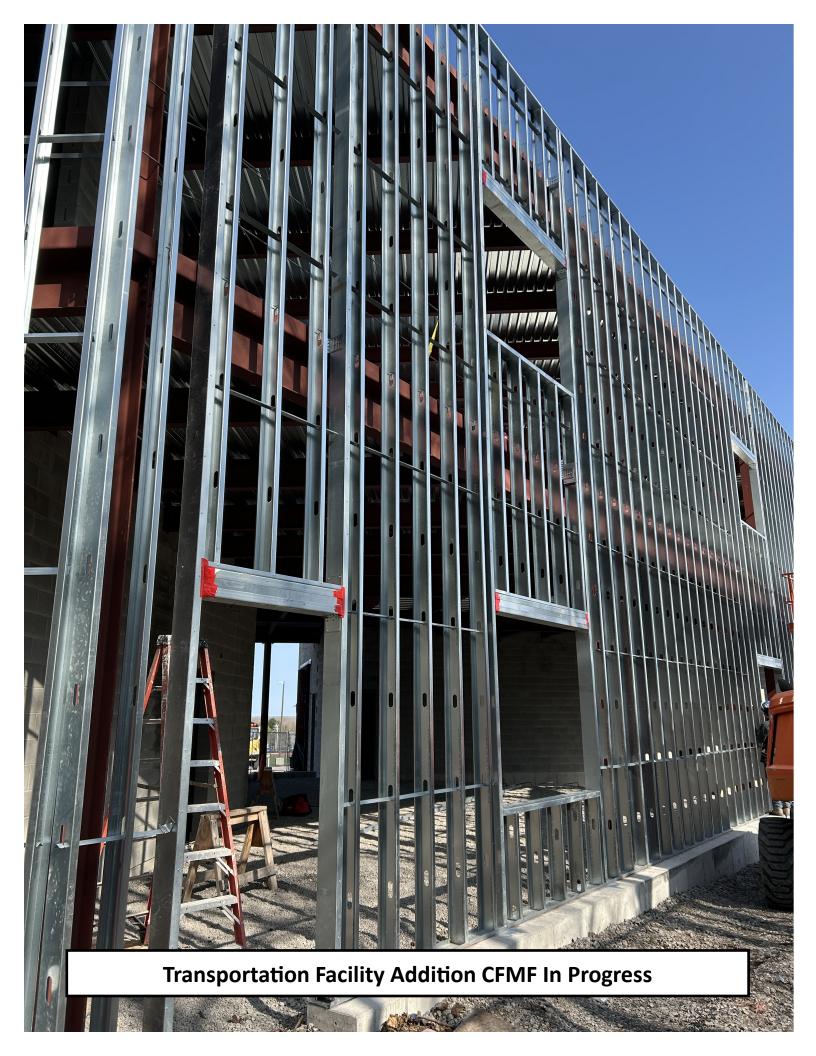

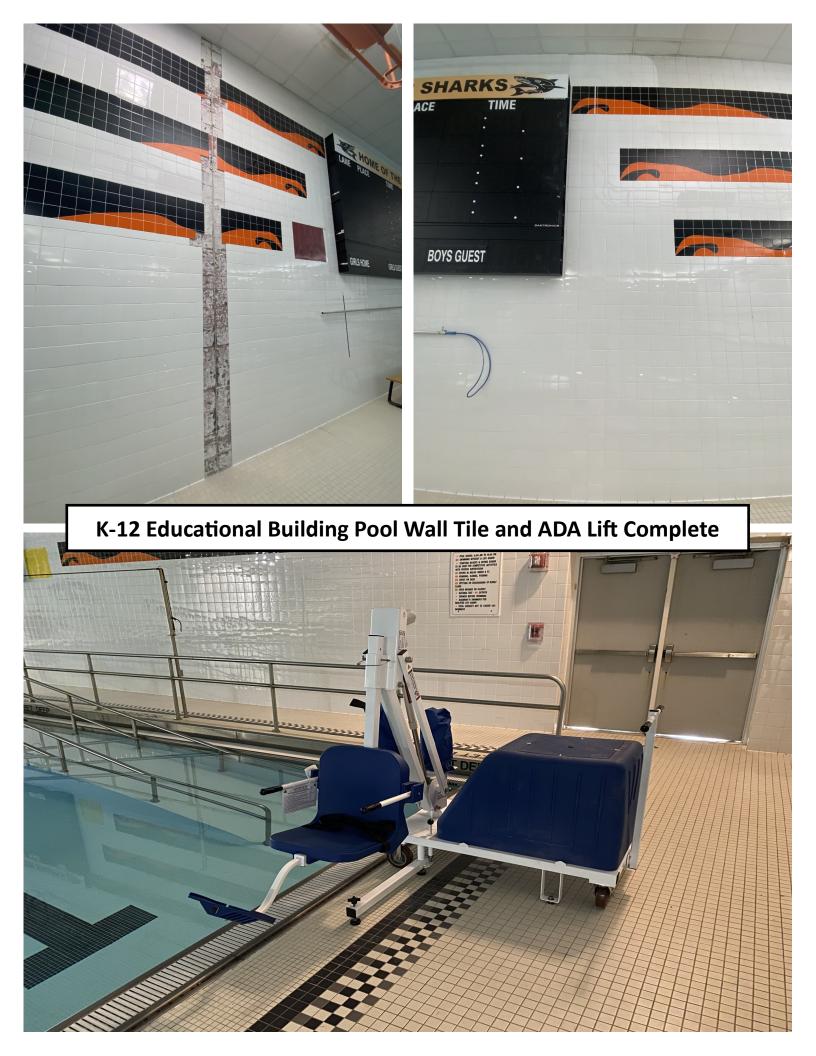
