Dear Akron Parents and Families,

Our district has created a plan for students to pick up their necessary learning materials over the next few days. This pick up is for essential items only related to instruction. Academic resources and instructional plans will be available on our website by Wednesday afternoon.

Elementary Procedure

On Thursday, March 19, 2020, we will be offering two times for you to pick up your child's supplies if he or she did not take them home already. Children in Kindergarten, Grades 4 and 5 brought their materials home on Friday. First, second, and third grade students need their chromebook. Second grade and UPK students need to receive their packets of work. Finally, we will have the necessary materials for any student who was absent on Friday, March 13th.

When?

Thursday, March 19, 2020 from 10:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. and 4:00-7:00 p.m.

Recommended Pick-Up Times

Please adhere, if possible, to the specific times indicated below in order to avoid congestion.

- Pre-K and Kindergarten - 10:00-11:00 a.m. and 4:00-5:00 p.m.
- First and Second Grade - 11:00-12:00 p.m. and 5:00-6:00 p.m.
- Third, Fourth, and Fifth Grade - 12:00-1:00 p.m. and 6:00-7:00 p.m.

To adhere to all recent safety recommendations, we have arranged pick up so you do not need to get out of your car or enter the building. The process will run the same as our daily afternoon pick up procedure. It would be very helpful if each family could bring their ID cards to show when they pull up. Please see more specific details below.

Where?

Elementary Side Lot

Parents picking up will enter the Akron Elementary Lot Entrance from Bloomingdale Avenue. Parents will pull forward staying to the right side nearest the curb. Please move forward as spaces are available. Pull forward as far as possible. Follow the directions from Akron Police for traffic flow.

Elementary Pick-Up Procedure:

1. As parents or family members pull forward, please tell the name of your child or children to the administrator lined along the curb or show your child's ID card provided to you earlier in the school year. Please note this is for Elementary students only.
2. The administrator will radio the name of the student to individuals inside who will bring your child's materials out. We ask for your patience as we work to get items out to you quickly, though we know there are a large number of students in need of their supplies.

Middle School Procedure

On Friday, March 20, 2020, we will be offering times for students to pick up their supplies if he or she did not take them home already. This supply pick up is limited to items in student lockers and teacher resources/handouts, if applicable.

To adhere to all recent safety recommendations, we have arranged for middle school families to drive up to **Door #22 (door next to the MS cafe)** to collect essential materials and chromebooks in a controlled process. Families will pull up, give us the student name and we will bring you the essential materials from student lockers. Please understand, we cannot let individuals in the building. School officials will retrieve student materials for you. Please let us know if you need a printed copy of the middle school assignment sheet.

Friday, March 20, 2020 from 11:00 a.m. -1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. -6:00 p.m.

Where?

Door #22; Middle School Parking Lot (Near Tennis Courts)

High School Procedure

On Monday, March 23, 2020, we will be offering times for Junior and Seniors to pick up their supplies if he or she did not take them home already. On Tuesday, March 24th, 2020 will be the date for Sophomores and Freshman. This supply pick up is limited to items in student lockers and teacher resources/handouts, if applicable.

To adhere to all recent safety recommendations, we have arranged for High school families to drive up to the flower pot entrance to collect essential materials and chromebooks in a controlled process. Please understand, we cannot let individuals in the building. School officials will retrieve student materials for you. Families will pull up to the flower pot door, give us the student name and we will bring you the essential materials from student lockers. Please be patient as we work through this process. Please let us know if you need a printed copy of the high school assignment sheet.
