Dear Akron Parents and Families,

Our district has established plans for picking up Chromebooks and Chromebook chargers/power cords (if needed) for Grades K through 12 only. The district will also be distributing one mask for each student and food service meal information. Students will need to bring their charged Chromebook to school on days they are attending in-person.

UPK Students

Students enrolled in the UPK program will have their Chromebooks distributed in classrooms during the first two days of school.

New Students to Akron Central School District including Kindergarten

New enrolled students should pick up their district issued Chromebook, Charger, and mask during the designated pick up dates.

Newly enrolled students and Kindergarten students will receive a Technology Welcome Packet along with their items. This packet will include login credentials and instructions.

Procedures

Families can choose any day and any time for pick up. This is a “drive thru” process and no cars should be parked for this pick up process.

When?

Thursday, August 27th from 8:00 a.m. - 5:30 p.m.

Friday, August 28th from 8:00 a.m. - 5:30 p.m.

To adhere to all recent safety recommendations, we have arranged the pick up so you do not need to get out of your car.

Where?

Front Bus Loop

Parents will enter the Akron bus loop from Bloomingdale Avenue and pull forward as far as possible towards the main entrance. Please move forward as spaces become available.

As parents or family members pull forward, **please have your child's/children's name written on a paper and the grade level they are entering for the 2020-2021 school year.** Runners will bring the devices to your vehicle.
