Submission Proposal March 2025



NYS Smart Schools Bond Act Initiative

- → Passed by New York Voters in November of 2014
- → Awarded \$2 Billion to all schools based on enrollment and state aid formula.
- → Akron's total allocation was <u>\$1,255,318</u>



Smart Schools Bond Act funds can be used for:

- → Classroom Connectivity
- → Classroom Technology
- → Community Connection
- → Pre-K Classroom Improvements
- → Elimination of Temporary/Trailer Classrooms
- → School Security and Safety



Smart Schools Bond Act funds can NOT be used for...

- \rightarrow Salaries
- → Software
- → Professional Development

Districts are expected to provide these as needed, but they cannot be funded from the Bond.



Akron Smart School Plan

- → The Smart School Planning Committee presented and the Board of Education adopted a \$144,018 Smart School Investment Plan submission in 2016 with expenditures for Classroom Connectivity (wireless infrastructure.)
- → Supplemental submissions were made in 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2024 totaling \$830,194.20 in expenditures for Classroom Technology (Chromebooks.)
- → Funds remaining from SSBA Allocation: \$197,164.10. Details on previous submission and expenditures can be found on our website at: <u>https://www.akronschools.org/Page/5396</u>



Proposed Submission

- Includes the the purchase of Chromebooks, Chrome Education Licenses, chargers, and protective cases. Estimated cost per student is ~\$340.
- The approved Technology Plan accounts for a regular replacement cycle of chromebook devices throughout the district.
- Students in grades 1, 5, 9 will receive new devices. Proposed expenditure= \$93,800.





- Members of the public and school community may submit comments and input related to this proposed plan. 30 days will be allowed for the submission of comments.
- 2. A Public Hearing will be held on **Tuesday**, **April 1st** providing additional opportunity for public comment.
- 3. Revisions will be made as necessary based on comments received to create a final plan.
- 4. A final plan may be adopted by the BOE and then submitted to NYSED for approval.
